

## Exodus Art

This unique artwork is located in the hallway to the right as you walk into the church lobby. It depicts significant events in the life of Moses, from his rescue in the Nile River to his looking over the Promise Land which he will not inhabit. Each piece of artwork could stand alone as a powerful Bible study.

The pieces were originally commissioned by a company in South Carolina to hang in their lobby. When the company was sold, Church of the Apostles was contacted to see if we could use them. Our construction of the education building and hallway they hang was approaching completion and it was a perfect fit.

Bases were built to support each piece of artwork which weights between 300lbs and 600lbs. The company in South Carolina paid over \$500K to have the artwork made. Our only expense was shipping and installation.

The significance of 'the artwork story' are

- (1) The uniqueness of the art itself
- (2) The wonderful stories each piece of art tells about the life of Moses and the acts of God through him
- (3) The art was a gift to the Church
- (4) The timing of the gift
