

Foundation of The Holy Apostles

The Foundation of the Holy Apostles was established in 1989 "...for religious, charitable, and educational purposes...including owning and leasing real estate and other property for the benefit of churches and other Christian nonprofit institutions whose mission is the proclamation of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ and whose ministries are evangelical in nature..." (Articles of Incorporation, Article III). The Foundation is an approved Internal Revenue Service (501) (c) (3) charity for tax purposes.

The Foundation has a Board of Trustees consisting of Dr. Michael Youssef and up to 15 Christian laymen, all whom share a common commitment to the Foundation's evangelical mission. As least one-half of the Trustees are parishioners of The Church of The Apostles. The remainder is laymen from various Christian denominations. A list of the present Trustees of the Foundation is following herewith. The Foundation is audited by Reed, Quinn, & McClure, C.P.A.. Its regular legal counsel is Wendell Bird of Bird and Associates.

In furtherance of its mission, the Trustees worked for over two years to come up with the most suitable property which could serve as a permanent home for The Church of The Apostles. In September of 1992, after extensive negotiations, the Trustees were able to obtain the Allstate site at Northside Parkway and West Paces Ferry Road, one of the most beautiful locations in the city of Atlanta. From the inception of the Foundation until now, the Trustees have raised funds from various friends throughout the Christian community and from the parishioners of Apostles to pay for the land and the renovation of the facility.
